



**WINNING WORDS  
TENNIS GLOSSARY**

Carefully read the tennis words and try to match them to the definitions.

<b>MINI TENNIS</b>	Stroke in which the ball is hit high above the net
<b>COURT</b>	Situation in which the player who is leading needs one more point to win the match.
<b>DEUCE</b>	The strokes played before point is won.
<b>DOUBLES</b>	Line at the farthest ends of the court indicating the boundary of the area of play.
<b>RALLY</b>	Posts on each side of the court which hold up the net.
<b>LET</b>	A score of zero.
<b>LOB</b>	Area designated for playing a game of tennis.
<b>LOVE</b>	Score of 40–40 in a game.
<b>MATCH POINT</b>	A call that requires the point to be replayed.
<b>NET POSTS</b>	Tennis played on smaller courts with shorter rackets and softer balls.
<b>BASELINE</b>	Match played by four players, two per side of the court.
